

# ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAMS - CREDIT FOR SJCC COURSES

The purpose of the Advanced Placement (AP) Exams - Credit for San José City College (SJCC) Courses chart is to provide students with information regarding how Advanced Placement (AP) Exams can be utilized to satisfy the requirements for various courses at SJCC, including both general education and major-specific courses. It is essential to recognize that the credits awarded by SJCC may differ from those granted by other colleges and universities. Therefore, students who intend to transfer to another institution are strongly encouraged to seek guidance from a college counselor, consult with university officials, refer to the college catalog, and review the advanced placement policies of their prospective transfer institutions.

While AP exams allow students to earn credit for specific courses at SJCC, only the AP exam results will be transcribed on the student's transcript, not the individual course credit.
