

HISTORY - ASSOCIATE IN ARTS FOR TRANSFER

To be awarded the Associate in Arts in History for Transfer degree, students must:

(1) Complete 60 semester units or 90 quarter units which are eligible for transfer to the California State University (CSU) system, including both of the following:

(A) The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University General Education – Breadth Requirements.

(B) A minimum of 18 semester units or 27 quarter units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by the community college district.

(2) Obtain a minimum grade point average of 2.0.

- Recognize connections between the past and the present; i.e., locate both self and others in time and space.
- Acquire familiarity with the uses—and the limitations—of historical comparison as an analytic tool.
- Demonstrate an ability to recognize and interpret multiple forms of historical evidence (visual, oral, statistical, artifacts from material culture).
- Recognize the distinction between primary and secondary sources, understand how each is used to make historical claims.
