

# APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Admission to San José City College (SJCC) is open to high school graduates, possess GED, certificate of proficiency, or the equivalent, or to those who are at least 18 years old.

The first step for all persons desiring to enroll in classes at SJCC is to complete an application for admission. This application is available online at, [www.cccapply.org](http://www.cccapply.org) (<http://www.cccapply.org>).

## Application for Non-Credit Courses

To enroll in a non-credit course, students need to:

1. Complete the online noncredit application via CCCApply (<https://www.opencccapply.net/gateway/apply/?cccMisCode=472&nonCredit=true>) or Download a separate PDF-writable **noncredit application** ([https://www.sjcc.edu/AdmissionsRecords/Documents/FINAL\\_NONcredit%20app.pdf](https://www.sjcc.edu/AdmissionsRecords/Documents/FINAL_NONcredit%20app.pdf)).
2. To complete the PDF-writable noncredit application, fill out the required information.
